- ✓ Criminal Record Certificate (from Tunisia)

- ✓ Bank statements for the last 6 months
- ✓ Proof of sufficient funds (€12,000 – €15,000 per year)
- ✓ Sponsor letter (if parents are sponsoring)
- ✓ Sponsor's financial documents (if applicable)

ADDITIONAL FOR TUNISIAN STUDENTS

- ✓ Strong Motivation Letter (We help you write this)
- ✓ Academic certificates & transcripts
- ✓ Official translations of all Arabic/French documents

Pro Tip: We review all your documents before submission to greatly reduce the chance of visa refusal.

Financial Requirements For Tunisian Students

How Much Money Do You Need to Show?

- ✚ Living Expenses
€12,000 – €15,000 per year of study
- ✚ Monthly Estimate
€800 – €1,100 per month
- ✚ Tuition Fees

Proof of at least 50% payment (sometimes 100%)

What We Recommend You Prepare:

- Bank statements for the last 6 months
- Sponsor letter (if parents or family are sponsoring)
- Sponsor's proof of income and bank balance
- Clear explanation of how your studies will be funded

Important Note:

Maltese authorities are strict with financial proof. Showing inconsistent or unclear funds is one of the most common reasons for, visa refusal.

Common Visa Refusals & How to Avoid Them

We have analyzed hundreds of Tunisian applications. Here are the most common reasons for refusal and how we help you avoid them.

1. Insufficient Proof of Funds

Problem: Unclear bank statements or sudden deposits

Solution: We help you prepare clean, consistent financial files with proper sponsor letters.

2. Weak or Generic Motivation Letter

Problem: Vague reasons for choosing Malta

Important Information

- You must apply for your Maltese Residence Card within 90 days of arrival.
- Students with Type D visa can work up to 20 hours per week during term time and full-time during holidays.
- We provide you with a detailed Arrival Guide and direct contacts for support after you arrive.

Frequently Asked Questions by Tunisian Students

Here are the most common and important questions asked by Tunisian students and their families.

- Q: Is it easy for Tunisian students to get a Malta student visa?**
A: The success rate is generally good if the file is well prepared. Our agency carefully reviews every application. The most common reasons for refusal are weak financial proof and poor documentation — both of which we help you avoid.
- Q: How much does it cost to study in Malta per year?**
A: Total cost (tuition + living expenses) usually ranges between €15,000 – €22,000 per year depending on the program. We provide a detailed cost breakdown in our separate Cost of Living Guide.
- Q: Can I stay in Malta after I finish my studies?**
A: Yes. After graduation, you can apply for a 6-month to 1-year job search visa. Many students later transition to a work visa or move to other European countries.

4. **Q: What is the minimum English level required?**

A: Many programs accept medium English levels. Some universities offer their own English test or pathway programs. We assess your level and recommend the best option.

5. **Q: Do I need to show a sponsor or can I use my own money?**

A: Both options are acceptable. Whether you are self-funded or have a sponsor (parents, family), we help you prepare the documents in the correct format that Maltese authorities expect.
